Charges for attendance of Customs officers outside working hours of 4

Regulation 5 is repealed and the following regulation is substituted—

- Charges for attendance of Customs officers outside working hours 65 of Customs
- Whenever, for the purpose of carrying out any provision of the Act, (1)any Customs officer is required to attend at any time outside the working hours of the Customs, the person in charge of or owner of any craft (or the agent of such a person), or the importer, or exporter, or licensee of a Customs controlled area, or other person concerned, in respect of whom or in respect of whose business such attendance is, in the opinion of the Comptroller, necessary, must pay a charge calculated in accordance with the following rates in respect of that attendance—
 - "(a) for attendance on any day that is
 - a working day (except the day after New Year's Day, or the day on which the gospel day of the island is observed in any particular place); or
 - a Saturday,— "(ii)"

\$28.60 per hour or portion of an hour:

- for attendance on any other day (including the day after New "(b) Year's Day or the day on which the gospel day of the island is observed in any particular place), \$38.25 per hour or portion of an hour.
- The Comptroller may exempt any person or class of persons from the "(2) requirement to pay a charge under subclause (1).
- A minimum charge of \$114.75 is payable for the attendance of any "(3) officer on any day that is
