



## PRICE ORDER 04/2022

**PURSUANT** to Section 16 of the Control of Prices Act 1966, the following Order is made:

- 1 This Order is cited as Price Order **04/2022** and shall come into effect on the **16th day of July 2022**
- 2 Maximum selling prices for petrol, diesel and LPG imported into the Cook Islands shall be at a rate specified in the schedule below.
- 3 For Aitutaki, maximum retail prices only are set for petrol, diesel and LPG.
- 4 For the Outer Islands, prices include freight, wharfage, boating, reefing, drum/container cost, evaporation and cartage costs.
- 5 For the Northern Group islands, retail LPG prices are not set.
- 6 Value Added Tax and import levies are included in the prices herein set, as applicable.
- 7 All previous references in any Price Order as to the selling prices listed in this Order are hereby revoked upon effective dates above.
- 8 The prices herein set are the maximum range that may be charged.
