Customs has alerts in place in its <u>ASYCUDA World System</u> against the tariff items in the <u>Working Tariff Document of the Cook Islands</u> for a wide range of items such as animal and animal products, plants, vehicles etc., which requires approval to import product and/or permit to land certificate.

Narcotics/Drugs	Bringing controlled drugs such as cannabis, methadone or pseudoephedrine into the Cook Islands is illegal and is prohibited unless you have a license to import from the Ministry of Health. Attempting to smuggle or import controlled drugs into country could result in imprisonment.
