I, understand that providing an incorrect or false declaration or documents to the Cook Islands Customs Service is an offence against Sections 260 and 261 of the Act and that penalties may apply which include a fine of up to \$3,000.00, or an imprisonment term not exceeding 6 months, or a fine not exceeding \$30,000 depending on the offence.

(Please note additional penalties may apply under the Act.)
