Notice to refuse entry into the Cook Islands

1. The Minister of Foreign Affairs and Immigration hereby issues a Notice not to permit Entry into the Cook Islands as per section 9A of the Entry, Residence and Departures Act 1971-72 on the following persons:

Persons intending to travel to the Cook Islands having originated from any country, with the exception of New Zealand and the Cook Islands, will require a 14 day self-quarantine period in New Zealand prior to entry into the Cook Islands.

Any person who does not complete this self-quarantine period will be denied entry into the Cook Islands.

This Notice is re-issued on this day 17 March 2020 at 12pm with expiry date 18 April 2020 and supersedes any earlier notice issued.
