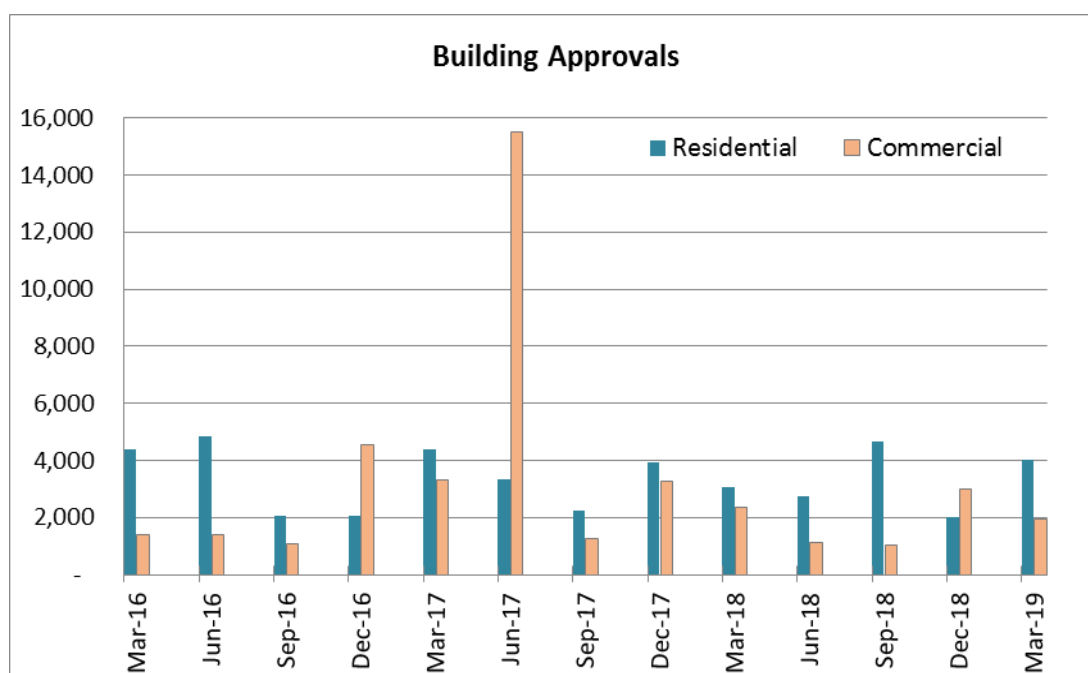

**MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS**  
**March Quarter 2019**

The Miscellaneous Statistics is a compilation of statistics from various data sources, such as building approvals, energy consumption, aircraft movement, motor vehicle registration, air cargo and climate.

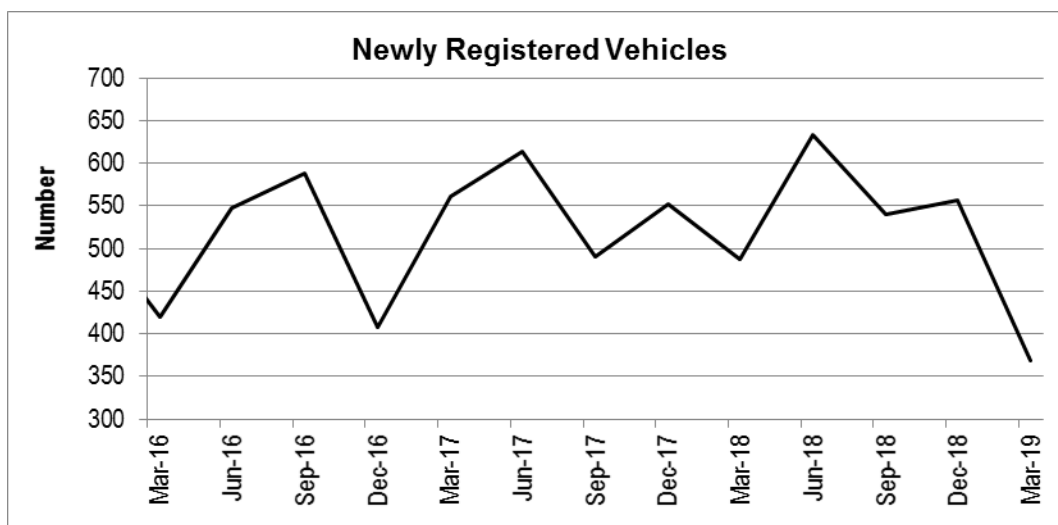
**Building Approvals** – The total value of buildings approved during the March quarter 2019 (5,975) increased by 19.6 per cent when compared to December quarter 2018 (5,702). Residential buildings contributed 67.2 per cent in the total value of building approvals and the Commercial buildings (Tourist Accommodation (1,160), Community (800)) contributed 32.8 per cent.



**Electricity Generated** - Total electricity and renewable energy generated in the Cook Islands for the March quarter 2019 was 10.6 million kWh, a 6.9 per cent decrease when compared to December quarter 2018. Of the total electricity and renewable energy generated 80.3 per cent was consumed on Rarotonga, followed by 19.7 per cent from the selected outer islands.

**Aircraft Movement** - International flights out of Rarotonga decreased by 52 flights in March quarter 2019 when compared to December quarter 2018. New Zealand continued to be the main destination with 162 international flights.

**Newly Registered Motor Vehicle** - Newly registered vehicles for March quarter 2019 decreased by 33.9 per cent compared to December quarter 2018. Motor cycles continued to be the highest type of vehicles registered (64.4 per cent), followed by Cars, Jeeps and Station Wagons (17.7 per cent), Vans and Pickups (10.1 per cent).



**Air Cargo** - The total weight of 436,000 kilograms of air cargo was recorded in the March quarter 2019. Of the total weight recorded for air cargo this is a 10.8 per cent decrease when compared to December quarter 2018. Air cargo imports recorded a total weight of 413,000 kilograms and for exports recorded a total weight of 23,000 kilograms for March quarter 2019. The actual value and descriptions of the air cargo imports/exports is captured in the Overseas Trade Statistics publication.

**Climate** - Rarotonga and Aitutaki recorded an average temperature of 26.9 and 25.9 degrees Celsius, with a total rainfall of 762 millimeters for Rarotonga and 598 millimeters for Aitutaki. Penrhyn had an average temperature of 29.2 degrees Celsius with a total rainfall of 513 millimeters during March quarter 2019. A total of 497 hours of sunshine was recorded for Rarotonga.
